
Information Box

Dandruff is a condition of the scalp that causes flakes (pul pul) of skin to appear.

Dandruff is a common condition, and causes itching (kaşınma).

Fortunately, dandruff can be controlled.

In mild cases, the person should find a suitable shampoo, which contains a gentle cleanser. When the dandruff is strong, you will need a medicated shampoo *(tibbi şampuan)*. Let us look at hair and roots first. Then we will look at hair and scalp problems.



Hair is simple in structure. It is made of a tough protein called keratin.

Hair growth is in three phases:

- Anagen (growth phase): Most hair is growing at any given time.
- **Catagen (transitional phase):** Over a few weeks, hair growth slows and the hair follicle(saç kökü) shrinks(azalmak).
- **Telogen (resting phase):** Over months, hair growth stops and the old hair dies. A new hair begins to grow, pushing the old hair out.

Hair grows at different rates in different people. The average is around one-and-a-half centimetres per month. As we get old pigment (colour) cells die, and the hair turns grey.

We all want to have perfect hair. Unfortunately some of us have hair and scalp problems.

Below you can see some hair and scalp problems.

NON-INFECTIOUS (bulaşıcı olmayan):

- dandruff and anti-dandruff shampoos.
- greasiness(shampoos for greasy hair)
- eczema(medical treatment)
- split ends(cutting and reconditioning treatment)
- tangled hair(reconditioning treatment/restructurants)
- swollen/ broken hair shaft (restructurants/ econdition and cut hair where possible)
- Ioose/ thinning hair
- grey hair
- dry scalp
- scalp acne




Here is some advice (rules) about personal and salon hygiene:

- Always work in a clean environment.
- Be very careful in your work. Careless work can lead to hair loss, hair breakage or damage to the customer's skin or eyes.
- Always clean, dry and sterilise the tools and equipment before using them with the next client
- Dont use broken tools, because they can be a source of infection.
- Give a clean towel and gown to each client.
- Sweep all waste hair up after every hair cut.
- Clean all work surfaces regularly with hot water and detergent.






