

How to cut hair

Hair cutting is an art form. Without a good, professional cut, styling has no basis.

Sectioning, using the comb and scissors, and understanding how to achieve balance in a style are essential elements of your learning. You should be able to create styles by using different cutting techniques. And you should be able to adapt your techniques to suit your individual clients' hair types and specific requirements. As well as having good technique, you should use care, precision, creativity and, above all, control.



Check your client's hair type, its texture, length, colour, quantity and quality. And look at the way the hair was cut before. Make sure that there is enough hair for the change of style. Always agree with your client how much hair you will be taking off. And remember to advise them on how to manage their new style at home.
